### DIRECTIONS FOR GENERAL CLASS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this pesticide inconsistent with its labeling.

Aquacide-11  
in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems must be cleaned to remove algal and other deposits. An initial slug addition of \_\_\_\_\_ Aquacide-11 \_\_\_\_\_ per \_\_\_\_\_ is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is achieved. Subsequent slug additions of 1.7 \_\_\_\_\_ Aquacide-11 \_\_\_\_\_ per 1000 gallons every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of additions should be made in the sump of water.
