

CATTLE BARNS

FILLING THE PERCH

The perch should be filled with a material that will not rot, decay, or become a breeding place for insects. The material should be packed firmly and should be flush with the ends of the perch.

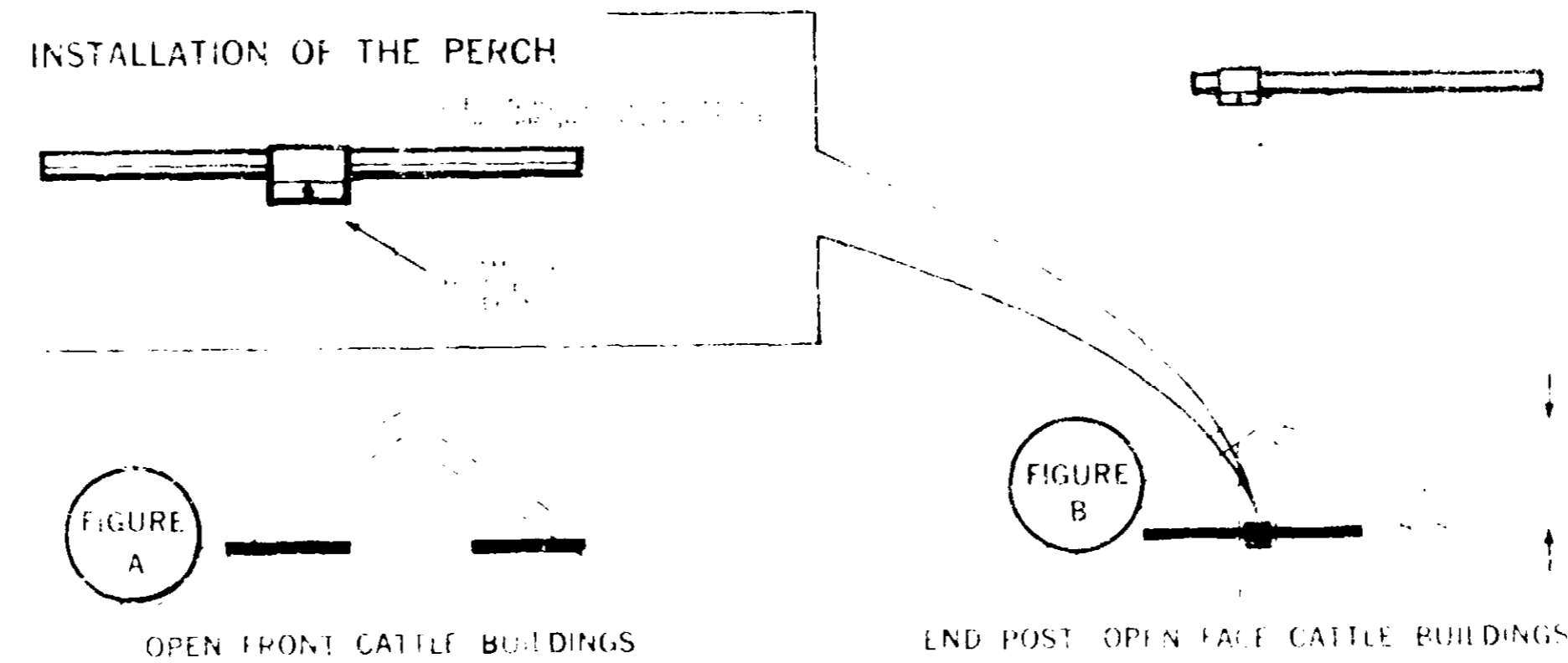
CAUTION

Do not use a perch made of wood that has been treated with creosote or other preservatives. These materials are highly toxic and can be fatal to cattle.

PERCH LOCATIONS

The perch should be located in a well-ventilated area of the barn. It should be located in a place where the cattle can easily reach it. The perch should be located in a place where it will not be damaged by the cattle.

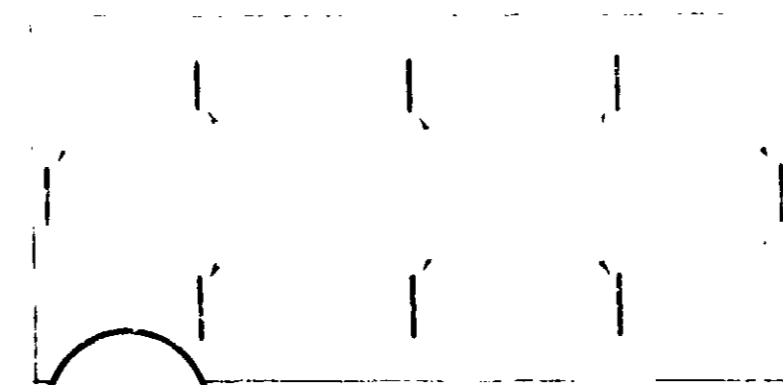
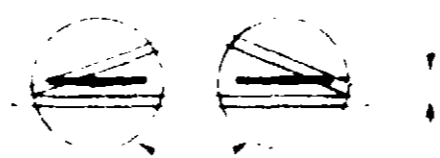
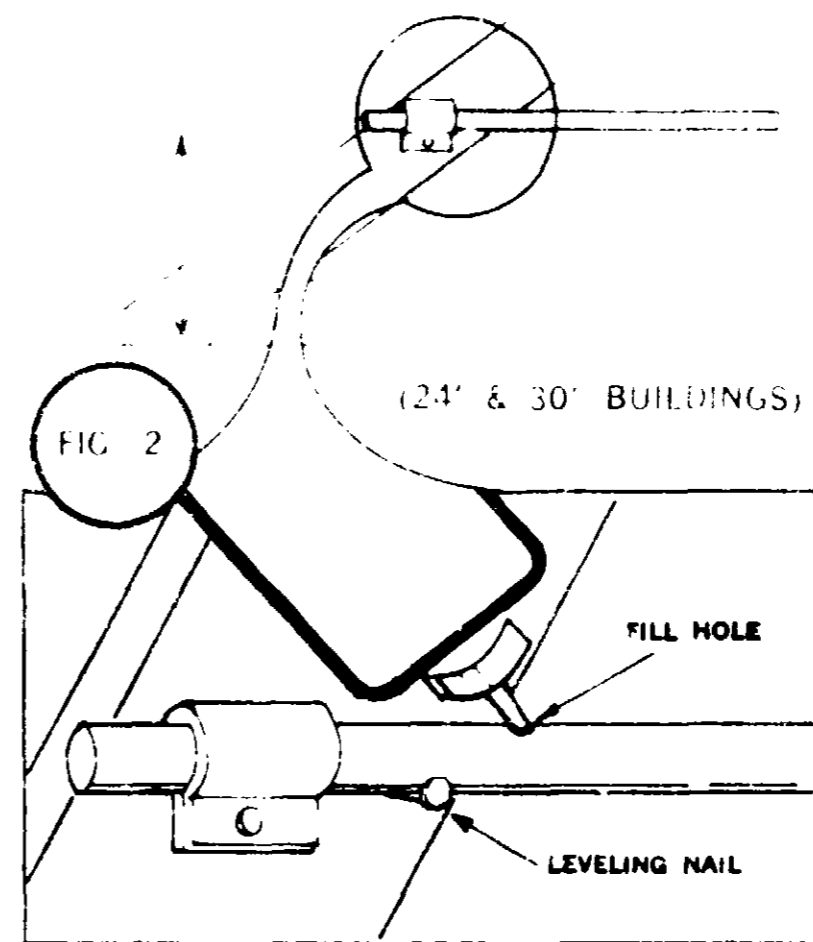
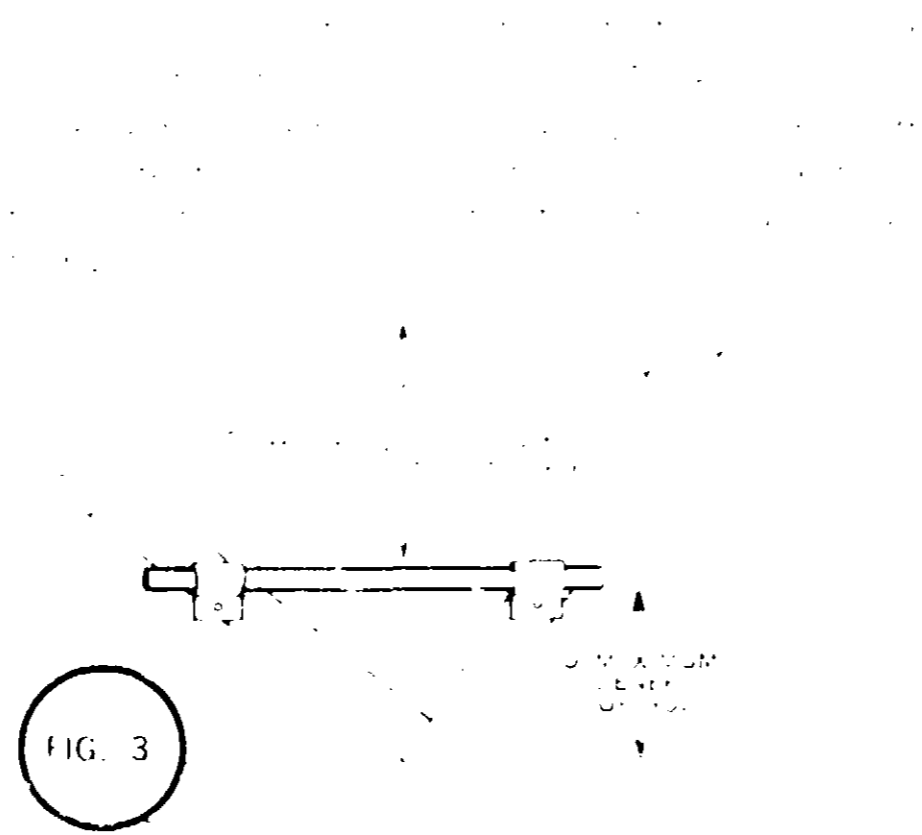

CATTLE BARN AND MACH. SHEDS

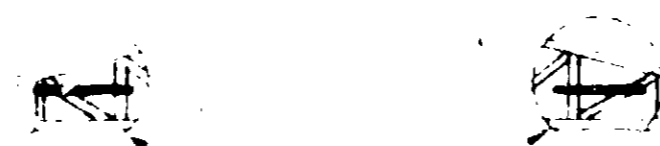
PERCH MOUNTING
