## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

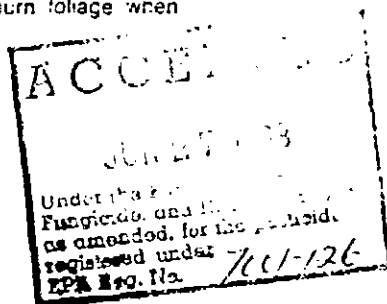
## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**Potatoes:** Blackleg, Fusarium Seed Piece Decay, and Seed Rot & scab. Apply 1 to 1 1/2 lbs. per 100 lbs. of seed. Cut seed should be treated immediately after cutting. Apply evenly to entire surface of seed. If treated whole seed is cut, a second application will be required after cutting. If planting is delayed, follow storage practices recommended in your area. Do not use treated seed for food or feed purposes.
