

## SWIMMING POOL CHLORINE

WARNING: Keep Out of Reach of Children

DIRECTIONS: For swimming pool sanitation and algae control, add 1 gallon pool chlorine to 150,000 gallons of pool water. Repeat until a chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm is obtained as determined by a suitable chlorine test kit. Check chlorine level each evening with test kit and add KemKlor as necessary to maintain 0.6-1.0 ppm. Generally ½ to 1 gallon will be required each evening during hot weather. Less will be required during cooler weather. Degrades with age. Use a test kit and increase dosage as necessary to obtain required level of available chlorine. Maintain pH between 7.2-7.6.

WARNING: Harmful if swallowed. Causes eye and skin irritation. Strong Oxidant. May produce chemical burns. Do not get in eyes or on skin.

FIRST AID: In case of eye contact flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention. In case of skin contact, flush off with water. If skin irritation persists get medical attention. If swallowed feed raw egg white, milk or cooked cereal. Call a physician immediately.

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge treated water into lakes, streams or ponds.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
