The presence of algae in outdoor swimming pools is objectionable because of the color, cloudiness, odor, and increased chlorine demand of the water. The use of Algy Bar 40 Algaecide will help to maintain the pool in a clean condition.

Algy Bar 40 is compatible with the usual water treatment chemicals. By controlling the algae growth with Algy Bar 40, the chlorine demand of the pool may be significantly reduced. This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. Apply this product only as specified on the label.

### DIRECTIONS

1. In freshly filled pools or in pools showing no visible algae growth, add one pint of Algy Bar 40 per 25,000 gallons of water to prevent algae growth. To estimate the number of gallons in your pool, refer to the table below.
2. If algae growth is observed, add one pint of Algy Bar 40 for each 10,000 gallons of water. When existing growth is dead, if necessary, clean the pool, drain, and refill, and add one pint Algy Bar 40 per 25,000 gallons of water.
3. After treatment, add one pint Algy Bar 40 per 25,000 gallons of water every 5-7 days.

### DANGER!
