Dear Mr. Somesla:

The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

Proposed Amendment

- Update Disposal Statement per PR Notice 2001-6
- Update Environmental Hazards Statement per PR Notice 93-10 and 95-1
- Update First Aid Statement per PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

Revise the "If Swallowed" section of the First Aid Statements to read: 1.

If Swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless

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told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

2. Revise the "If In Eyes" section of the First Aid Statements to read:

If In Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

3. Revise the "If On Skin or Clothing" section of the First Aid Statements to read:

If On Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

- 4. The ingredient statement must total 100%.
- 5. Delete the "s" from the active ingredient heading since this product contains only one(1) active ingredient.

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A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit three(3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.



- 1. Adjust pH of pool water to 7.2 7.6. Use Kem Tek Buffered Soda Ash to raise pH and Kem Tek Muiatic Acid to lower it. Follow directions on the label of whichever product is used.
- 2. Add 1 pound SHOCK per 10,000 gallons of water to oxidize water soluble wastes. Allow to circulate one hour. (NOTE: Do not enter pool until chlorine residual drops to 2.0 ppm.)
- 3. Add 10 oz. of ALGY COP per 10,000 gallons of water. Preferably, dilute concentrate into one or two gallons of water and apply to deep end of pool.
- 4. Filter continuously for 24 hours.
- 5. Remove dead algae by brushing and vacuuming as needed.
