For black algae problems, the use of KEM TEK™ All-In-One Algaecide is recommended. Follow all precautions, directions and restrictions per their labeling for all pesticide products being used.

1. Adjust pH of pool water to 7.2-7.6. Use KEM TEK™ pH PLUS (Soda Ash) to raise pH and KEM-TEK™ MURIATIC ACID to lower it. Follow the instructions on the label of whichever product is used.
2. Add 1 pound of KEM TEK™ SHOCK QUICK™, or 3 quarts of KEM-TEK™ SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATING LIQUID per 10,000 gallons of pool water to oxidize water soluble wastes. Allow to circulate one hour. (NOTE: Do not enter the pool until chlorine residual drops to 2.0 ppm.)
3. Using an algae brush, brush algae spots prior to product application. Brush daily for the next few days if necessary to promote penetration of product into algae spots to improve effectiveness.
