Dear Ms. Campbell:

On behalf of KIK Pool Additives Inc., I am submitting a notification per PR Notice 98-10 for the product label Algy Cop, EPA Reg. No. 7616-68. The purpose of the notification is to clarify the label and make minor changes. The label on file with EPA used underlines to show language pertaining to the alternate formula. In preparing marketplace labeling, we found this confusing. Therefore we have revised the label to include two sets of directions, one for the basic and one for the alternate, and have eliminated the underlining. The alternate formula has an ingredient that assists the settling of dead algae for easier removal, so slightly different label language is appropriate; EPA recognized this with the previous approved label. We have clarified and moved wording but made no substantive changes to the directions approved previously.

In addition we also are making the following changes:

- Adding the Alternate brand name HDX All-In-One Algaecide
- Adding minor label claims (page 2) and one minor graphic (page 4, highlighted)
- Correcting re-entry level for chlorine residual (2 ppm to 3ppm as is standard)
- Adding clarifying reader's notes

- 4) Filter continuously for 24 hours.
- 5) Remove dead algae by brushing and vacuuming as needed.
- 6) Add 5 oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water every two weeks as a maintenance dose.

[Directions for use: Alternate Formula Only:]

- 1) Adjust pH of pool water to 7.2-7.6. Use KEM TEK pH PLUS (soda ash) to raise pH and KEM TEK MURIATIC ACID [or muriatic acid] to lower it. Follow the instructions on the back panel of whichever product is used.
- 2) Add 1 pound of KEM TEK SHOCK QUICK [[or other EPA approved shock product] [, or 3 quarts of KEM TEK KEMKLOR II CHLORINATING LIQUID][or other EPA approved chlorinating liquid]] per 10,000 gallons of pool water to oxidize water soluble wastes. - 6) Once algae is dead, turn off filter system (including timer) allow 18 to 24 hours for dead algae to settle to the bottom of the pool.
- 7) Remove dead algae by brushing and vacuuming as needed. Backwash the filter. Return filter system to normal operation.
- 8) Add 5 oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water every two weeks as a maintenance dose.
