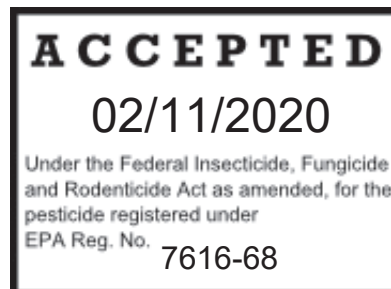

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Algy Cop [This product] does an effective job of controlling green, blue-green and mustard colored algae growth in swimming pools. [For black algae problems, the use of KEM TEK BLACK ALGAE TREATMENT is recommended.] Follow all precautions, directions and restrictions per their labeling for all pesticide products being used.

- 1) Adjust pH of pool water to 7.2-7.6. Use KEM TEK pH PLUS (soda ash) to raise pH and KEM TEK MURIATIC ACID [or muriatic acid] to lower it. Follow the instructions on the [label] [back panel] of whichever product is used.
- 2) Add [1 pound of KEM TEK SHOCK QUICK] [[or other EPA approved shock product] [, [or] 3 quarts of KEM TEK KEMKLOR II CHLORINATING LIQUID]][or other EPA approved chlorinating liquid]] per 10,000 gallons of pool water to oxidize water soluble wastes. Allow to circulate one hour. (Note: Do not enter the pool until chlorine residual drops to 3.0 ppm).
- 3) Add 10 oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water. Preferably, dilute the concentrate into one or two gallons of water and apply to the deep end of the pool.
- 4) Filter continuously for 24 hours.
- 5) Remove dead algae by brushing and vacuuming as needed.
- 6) Add 5 oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water every two weeks as a maintenance dose.

**DISCHARGE DIRECTIONS FOR RESIDENTIAL POOL USES** - Before draining a treated pool, contact your local sanitary sewer and storm drain authorities and follow their discharge instructions. Do not discharge treated pool water to any location that flows to a gutter, storm drain or natural water body unless discharge is allowed by state and local authorities.

- 1) Adjust pH of pool water to 7.2-7.6. Use KEM TEK pH PLUS (soda ash) to raise pH and KEM TEK MURIATIC ACID [or muriatic acid] to lower it. Follow the instructions on the back panel of whichever product is used.
- 2) Add 1 pound of KEM TEK SHOCK QUICK [[or other EPA approved shock product] [, or 3 quarts of KEM TEK KEMKLOR II CHLORINATING LIQUID]][or other EPA approved chlorinating liquid]] per 10,000 gallons of pool water to oxidize water soluble wastes. Allow to circulate one hour. (Note: Do not enter the pool until chlorine residual drops to 3.0 ppm).
- 3) Using an algae brush, brush algae spots prior to product application. Add 10 oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water. Preferably, dilute the concentrate into one or two gallons of water and apply to the deep end of the pool.
- 4) Filter continuously for 24 hours. Brush daily for the next few days if necessary to promote penetration of product into algae spots to improve effectiveness. Periodically check available chlorine and adjust if necessary to maintain a 3 ppm minimum during treatment.
- 5) Dead algae may be visible as a gray or white cloudiness. Living algae will have a green, brown, yellow or black color. If algae has color after 24 hours, repeat treatment as necessary for removal.
- 6) Once algae is dead, turn off filter system (including timer). Allow 18 to 24 hours for dead algae to settle to the bottom of the pool.

- 7) Remove dead algae by brushing and vacuuming as needed. Backwash the filter. Return filter system to normal operation.
- 8) Add 5 oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water every two weeks as a maintenance dose.

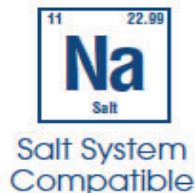
