NOTE: Products that, indeed, are 100% re-packs of other EPA-registered products must have labeling that is identical in every aspect, except for the product name and company name and address.
- c. Submit three copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

The presence of algae in swimming pools is objectionable and can be difficult to remove. Directions For Use

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Freshly Filled And/Or Algae-Free Swimming Pools: Add 8 ounces of ALGAECIDE 60% CONCENTRATED per 10,000 gallons pool water. Add 2 to 3 ounces (per 10,000 gallons) weekly as a maintenance dose to prevent algae growth through the swimming season.

Visible Algae Growth: Super-chlorinate with a fast-acting, unstabilized chlorinating product (such as SHOCK™) to a chlorine reading of 5 ppm. Remove all debris by vacuuming or sweeping and filtering. In order to aid in the removal of the fine particles resulting from the affected algae, the use of ULTRA CLARIFIER is recommended. Add an initial dose of 8 ounces of ALGAECIDE 60% CONCENTRATED per 10,000 gallons of water to rid the water of the remaining chlorine-resistant algae. Thereafter, add 2 to 3 ounces (per 10,000 gallons) weekly during swimming season to prevent regrowth of algae.
