TERMITE CONTROL

Clean out carefully all loose wood and debris under or around infested buildings. Spray all ground under buildings at rate of 2 gallons of PENTA WOOD PRESERVATIVE per 5 cubic feet of ground. Break all wood to expose concrete, such as steps, door frames, etc., and replace with PENTA treated wood in concrete. Where construction permits dig a trench around all foundation to a depth of 12 to 18 inches. For buildings with deep foundation, dig 36 inches deep. Apply five gallons of PENTA WOOD PRESERVATIVE to 5 lineal feet of trench up to 15 inches deep; ten gallons per 10 lineal feet for deeper trenches. Trees, shrubbery or flowers should be protected from the soil by tar or heavy kraftpaper.
