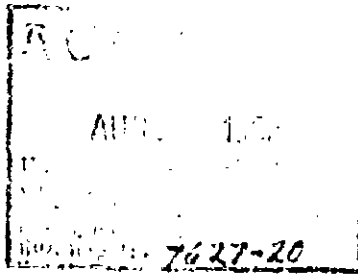

INGREDIENTS

Monocalcium and dicalcium phosphate, calcium carbonate, urea, salt, soybean meal, cottonseed meal, meat and bone meal, corn distillers dried grains with solubles, sulfur, dried cane molasses, cane molasses, manganese oxide, iron oxide, iron sulfate, zinc oxide, copper sulfate, cobalt sulfate, ethylenediamine dihydrochloride, vitamin B12 supplement, choline chloride, niacin, d-calcium pantothenate, riboflavin supplement, dehydrated alfalfa meal (preserved with ethoxyquin), vitamin A supplement, d-activated animal sterol, animal fat (preserved with BHT), natural and artificial flavors.

CAUTION

Do not feed to lactating dairy animals. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. If in eyes, wash with plenty of water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, see a physician.

LIVESTOCK REMEDY—NOT FOR HUMAN USE

Occasional sensitivity to phenothiazine has been reported and under certain conditions that drug is toxic to livestock. Animals that are sick, lame, weak, anorectic or show signs of extreme constipation, should not be treated except upon the advice of a veterinarian. Do not administer to pregnant animals in the last 4 weeks of pregnancy. Avoid exposure of freshly treated animals to bright sunlight because of danger of photosensitization. Do not use with organophosphates or administer to animals showing symptoms of acute respiratory conditions.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Stockade Para-Gard should be offered to cattle free choice, as the sole source of mineral and salt. Adult cattle must consume 6 ounces of Stockade Para-Gard per head per day in order to receive 2 grams of phenothiazine. Younger cattle must consume 0.75 ounce per 100 lbs. body weight per head per day to receive the intended 0.25 gram of phenothiazine. Continuous year-round use of Stockade Para-Gard, in conjunction with good feed management practices, will control the spread of parasites and help prevent reinfection.

NOTE: This product kills horn fly and face fly maggots in manure, but does not control existing adult flies. It is necessary spray cattle for maximum protection. Because face flies migrate from farm to farm, it is essential that a fly control program be employed on an area basis to assist in reducing the adult face fly population.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not store used to herbicides. If it contains water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Container Disposal: Completely empty bag by shaking and tipping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue in animal feeders. Treat disposal of bags as sanitary landfill or by incineration of allowed by State and local authorities.
