DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HARD SURFACE DISINFECTION

Apply solution with a mop, cloth, sponge, or chemicals sprayer. Wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow to remain wet 10 minutes, then rinse or let dry. Rinse surfaces immediately with clean water if contact with food. For bacterial disinfection, add 1/2 cup of bleach per gallon of solution. For Hospital Disinfection, add 1 cup of bleach per gallon of solution. Note: Bleach is a strong oxidizing agent. Do not mix with ammonia.

TOILET BOWL DISINFECTION

Use 1/2 cup of solution per gallon of water. Flush thoroughly after use.

MOLD AND MILDEW CONTROL

Apply solution to mold and mildew. Rub with a brush. Rinse with water. Repeat as necessary.

SANITIZATION

Apply solution to surfaces. Rinse with water. Repeat frequently if soiling persists.

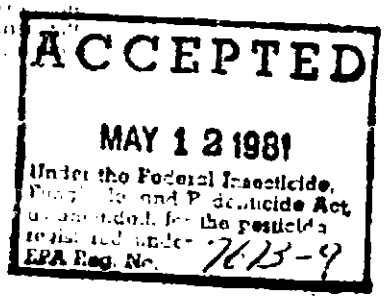
