This product is conditionally registered in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) section 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Within six months of the date of registration submit to the Agency a new dermal sensitization study (guideline reference no. 81-6). The product label may be subject to additional changes once review of this data is completed.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 7673-11.
- b. On the front panel of label revise the statement, "the alternative to organo-phosphate insecticides", so that it reads:

"An alternative to organo-phosphate insecticides"
- c. On the back panel revise the statement, "Secta effectively kills selected insects in your home, garden, and greenhouse", so that it reads:

"Secta effectively kills listed insects on plants in your home, garden, and greenhouse."

- e. On the back panel remove the statement "Secta kills insect pests fast, then breaks down quickly, with no residual effects." This is considered an implied safety claim in accordance with 40 CFR §156.10.
- d. In accordance with PR Notice 93-3 add, "for terrestrial uses", to the beginning of the second sentence of the Environmental Hazards section.
- e. Change the last word of the Environmental Hazards statement from "water" to "wastes".

3. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.


Please note that the Confidential Statement Formula (CSF) dated April 28, 1993 is considered the Basic CSF and all others submitted in the past are obsolete.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Spray when insects first appear, or damage is noticed. Thoroughly spray all infested areas to the point of runoff, hitting insects directly with insecticide spray where possible. Apply weekly as needed (repeat application after 2 or 3 days to control aphids and mealybugs).

Can be used up to day of harvest.

DO NOT USE ON NEW TRANSPLANTS, UNROOTED CUTTINGS, OR PLANTS STRESSED BY DROUGHT. THIS PRODUCT IS NOT RECOMMENDED FOR POINSETTIA SPECIES.

Avoid spraying in full sun when temperatures exceed 90° F. Do not spray fruit trees when blooms are present. If wilting occurs within a few hours of spraying, rinse with a spray of fresh water.

Kills: Adelgids, Aphids, Cabbageworms, Crickets, Earwigs, Flea Beetles, Grasshoppers, Lace Bugs, Leafhoppers, Mealybugs, Mites, Plant Bugs, Psyllids, Rose Slugs, Sawfly Larvae, Scales, Squash Bugs, Stink Bugs, Tent Caterpillars, Thrips, Whiteflies.
