The following requirements or revisions apply to the label which was accepted with this registration notice:

1. An edited copy of the proposed label is enclosed indicating the revisions which must be made to your label to satisfy our requirements.
2. The registration number which has been assigned to this product must appear on the label as EPA Registration No. 7675-9.
3. Under "Directions", add a paragraph such as: "Use a reliable test kit with fresh solutions for pH and chlorine testing".
4. Under "Directions", add a paragraph such as: "Note. Shower before using spa. Do not add foodstuffs or beverages to water. Do not use soap in water. Do not use lotions or oils on parts of the body in contact with water. Avoid overloading spa."
5. The labels which will be used for this product in channels of trade must reflect these revisions.
6. Five copies of the finished printed labels, as defined in the A-79 enclosure, must be submitted to the Agency before the product is released for shipment to comply with PR Notice 82-2 of June 18, 1982.
7. The finished printed labels must comply with the general labeling requirements of Section 162.10 of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations. If the label does not satisfy these requirements it will be rejected.

Effective use of all spa sanitizers depends on maintaining proper water balance. The following ranges are highly recommended:

pH 7.4 - 7.8  
Total Alkalinity 125-150 ppm  
Calcium hardness 200-300 ppm  
Maximum Available Chlorine 2.0 - 3.0 ppm

### DIRECTIONS

FORMULA 2 SPA SHOCK is compatible with all spa sanitizers. However, always add spa chemicals separately. Use FORMULA 2 SPA SHOCK daily when the water appears dingy or hazy from bather contamination. Turn off the air blower and circulation system. Sprinkle 1 oz. per 250 gallon of FORMULA 2 SPA SHOCK into the water. The granules will dissolve completely within seconds and liberate 10 ppm of available chlorine. Allow the ensuing reaction to proceed for 10-15 minutes before covering the spa. Turn on the circulation system. Bathers should not re-enter the spa until the available chlorine residual falls to 3.0 ppm.

FORMULA 2 SPA SHOCK should not be used more than once a week. If a spa is used daily it should be drained completely and re-sanitized once a month.

In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all materials before disposing this container.
