DIRECTIONS AND APPLICATION ARE IMPORTANT

A gelatin chemical compound that is best applied with a caulking gun, brush or paddle, in the form of lines one inch thick and one-half inch wide and one-half inch from edge of sills, ledges, etc.

These lines are placed three (3") inches apart for pigeons if the ledge is wide and two (2") inches apart for starlings. On cornices, ledges and coping apply one line for every three (3") inches.

On rain gutters, one line should be placed on outer tip and a broken line around the down spout. On roof saddles and gables, application should be made on all possible roosting areas.
