1 1/2 DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Surfaces to be treated should be free from heavy accumulations of residue. **COAL TAR DISINFECTANT** will satisfactorily clean hard surfaces, such as floors and walls, when diluted using 1 to 5 ounces of the concentrate to each gallon of tap water. This level of dilution will control many microorganisms which contaminate the listed areas.

Spores arising from refuse areas, such as garbage dumps, industrial or municipal sediment pools, may be reduced by a heavy sprinkling of 4 ounces of disinfectant to each gallon of water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store only in tightly closed, original container in a secure area, inaccessible to children. Do not contaminate food, water or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or empty container is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the hazardous waste representative at the nearest E.P.A.
