Under the WPS labeling regulations at 40 CFR part 156, subpart K, §156.200(c)(3), you are prohibited from distributing or selling any product within the scope of the WPS requirements after April 21, 1994, without amended labeling accepted by the Agency. Our records do not indicate your having submitted a label revised according to the WPS for our review and approval.

CROP ROTATION STATEMENT

Subsequent planting of food and feed crops in treated soil must be made with crops on this or other carbaryl label(s).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste facility.

Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Organophosphate N-Methyl Carbamate

For the control of Cutworms, Crickets, Darting Ground Beetles and Earwigs on the following crops:

Broccoli, Cabbage, Cauliflower and Lettuce, (seedling stage only). Apply 30 to 40 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest.

Corn, Sorghum, Tomatoes, Peppers, Beans, Carrots, Potatoes and Sugar Beets: Apply 30 to 40 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest for the above crops, except sorghum for grain within 21 days of harvest or within 14 days if sugar beet tops are to be used for food or feed.

Alfalfa, Clover and Peas: Apply at the rate of 30 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest.

Asparagus: Apply at the rate of 30 to 40 pounds per acre no later than one day before harvest. Do not repeat applications within 3 days.

Grapes: Apply at the rate of 30 to 40 pounds per acre. No time limitation.

Cucumbers, Melons, Pumpkin, Squash, Safflower and Sunflowers, (seedling stage only): Apply at the rate of 30 to 40 pounds per acre.

NOTE: The above damage directions are for overall broadcast treatments. If applied as a band application, reduce dosage accordingly.
