
WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Breccell, Cabbage, Cauliflower and Lattuce, (seedling stage only): Apply 30 to 40 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 3 days of hervest.

Corn, Sorghum, Tometoes, Peppers, Beans, Cerrots, Potatoes and Sugar Beets: Apply 30 to 40 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest for the above crops, except sorghum for grain within 21 days of harvest or within 14 days if sugar beet tops are to be used for food or feed.

Allette, Clover and Pees: Apply at the rale of 30 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest.

Asperagus: Apply at the rate of 30 to 40 pounds per acre no later than one day before harvest. Do not repeal applications within 3 days.

Grapes: Apply at the rate of 30 to 40 pounds per acre. No time limitation.

Cucumbers, Melens, Pumpkin, Squash, Selflewer and Sunflewers, (seedling stage only): Apply at the rate of 30 to 40 pounds per acre.

NOTE: The above damage directions are for overall broadcast trustments. If applied as a band application, reduce riosage accordingly.
