3. The product chemistry data for the technical and end-use product produced by integrated formulation are deficient. The following data are needed:

Series 61:

- a. The range of the molecular weight for your refined oil is needed.
- b. Provide evidence that the purified oil does not contain polymers and other oil additives in the starting material.
- c. The Agency requires the analysis of starting material, comparing it with a representative virgin oil used for similar purposes.
- d. The process in which you add the inert in the purified oil must be described.
- e. A discussion of the potential formation of impurities during the purification of oil is required.

Series 62:

- a. Analysis of five batches of oil obtained on different days must be analyzed for their aromatic, naphthenic and aliphatic components. Report also unsulfonating residues for each sample. Method validation is also

required.

- b. All items in column 13a of the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) should be reported in pounds per batch of production rather than per gallon.
- c. Recalculate percent amounts reported under column 13b.
- d. The upper and lower limits for the inert should not vary more than 5% from the nominal.

Series 63:

The following deficiencies are for the technical:

63-8 Solubility: It should be reported with various polar and non-polar solvents.

63-11 Octanol/Water Partition Coefficient is needed.

63-12 pH: If pH is not applicable indicate so.

63-13 Stability: Provide stability information with regards to metal ions and metals, to normal and elevated temperatures and to sunlight.

The following data are required for the end-use product:

63-12 pH: If pH is not applicable indicate so.

63-14 Oxidizing/Reducing action: If none indicate so.

63-16 Explodability: If none indicate so.

63-17 Storage Stability: Data are required. Analyze the product after formulation and again after one year storage at room temperature.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed label.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
