### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR GENERAL DISINFECTION OF HARD SURFACES, such as floors, walls, operating tables, cages and furniture in animal hospitals, kennels, animal quarters and laboratories: Clean thoroughly and rinse all surface areas before disinfecting. Then apply Roccal-D dilution 1:400 by mop, sponge, or spray and let air dry. For surfaces difficult to clean and heavily contaminated areas, use Roccal-D dilution 1:200.

FOR DISINFECTION OF EATING AND DRINKING UTENSILS for animals not considered as food sources for human consumption: Scrape and pre-wash with warm water, then soak in Roccal-D dilution 1:400 for at least 10 minutes, and rinse with potable water.
