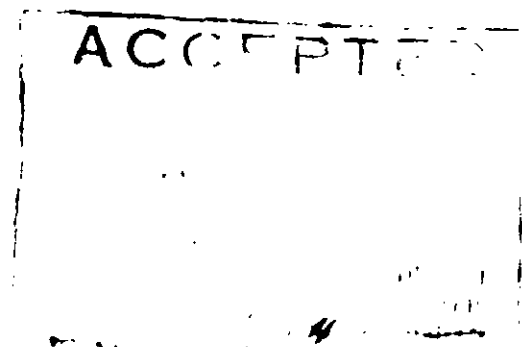
DIRECTIONS FOR USE: To prevent your pet or stray animals from soiling flower beds, areas of lawn, trees, shrubbery or evergreens, lightly spray the edges of flower beds, trunks of trees, evergreens, patches of lawn, corners of buildings, etc. with this product. Stray animals are frequently attracted to areas where urine or feces have been deposited. First, remove any droppings; then spray the spot with this masking odor. Re-apply as necessary until undesirable habits of your pet or stray animals are changed. The most effective control for a pet is the sharply spoken word backed up with disciplinary action. The repellent product should be used in conjunction with training.
