- 2. Change the Precautionary Statements to read as follows: "Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."
- 3. Change the existing header "Statement of Practical Treatment" and associated text as follows: 1

## "FIRST AID

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repellents over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin.<sup>4</sup> Do not allow children to handle this product, and do not apply to children's hands. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.
- 9. Remove the "%" from the Trade name, since the product does not contain 100% active ingredient.
