Review of label The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you release product for shipment. A copy of the stamped label is enclosed for your records.

1. Revise your "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" text as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: Do Not ... instructions.

2. Left justify your subheadings ("Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" and "Physical or Chemical Hazards") and "CAUTION" to distinguish them from the major heading, "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS".

- 3. Revise the beginning of your "FIRST AID" text to streamline the presentation:

FIRST AID

Have label with you when seeking treatment advice.
 Call poison control center, doctor, or International Poison Center (1-888-740-8712).

Existing stocks Stocks of existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.

Consequence for non-compliance If these conditions are not complied with, the registrations will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
