CAUTION

Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, particularly under rafters, contacting as many insects as possible. Saturate areas in and around nest openings. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SPIDERS: Spray directly on these pests and use repeated applications to the webbing to all cracks and crevices which harbor spiders.

OUTDOORS TO INSECTS: WASPS, HORNETS, YELLOW JACKETS: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Aim spray at nest openings in trees, bushes, under eaves, chimneys, cracks and crevices to saturate in and around nest openings. Contact as many insects as possible.

Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SPIDERS: same as directed for indoor applications.

STORAGE: Keep in locked storage area.
CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Pour into soil and discard container in trash.
