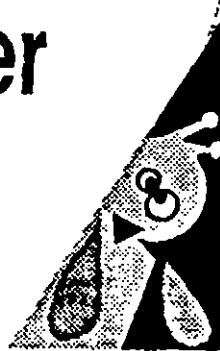
For reg. no. 7754-40, reinstate the ingredient substatement for MGK 326-\*\*MGK repellent 326.

- Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness.
- After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water and treated clothing.
- Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you or your child is reacting to this product, wash with water and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, show the repellent with you.
- It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To repel the insects listed on the Front Panel, apply liberally to exposed skin areas. To apply to face, sponge hands and rub into eyes and lips. Repeat as needed. For ticks and chiggers, liberally to shoe tops, socks and around openings in clothing.

Avoid contact with plastics, such as eyeglass frames, and sun acetate rayon.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- Storage:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.
- Disposal:** Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
