Dear Ms. Artis:

The Agency in accordance with the Federal Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as Amended (FIFRA) has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the aforementioned product in connection the MGK 326 RED, and have concluded that your submission is acceptable.

Current labels on DEET repellent products tend to dissolve from contact with the repellent (usually liquids). All registered DEET product labels must use materials that remain permanent and readable for the reasonable life of the product. The Agency determined in the DEET RED document that all aerosol and pump spray formulations must be packaged in containers utilizing a concave trigger to help aim product or other comparable mechanism that will ensure that the product will not be inadvertently sprayed in the eyes.

The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

In addition, should you wish to retain a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) lists examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved

registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance. As an alternative, you may refer consumers to the company's phone number or email address.

**NOTE:** This product is not being re-registered under FIFRA Sec. 4(g) at this time.

ARI should note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility decision (RED) documents for products containing:

- MGK 264 was published in the *Federal Register* July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143) Page 42381-42383).

As a result of this RED, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing MGK 264.

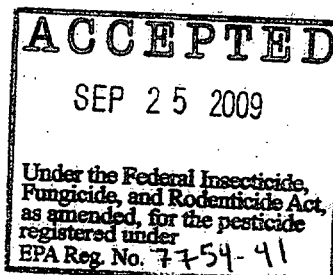

Do not apply near eyes or mouth. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Apply sparingly around ears.

Do not allow children to handle this product, and do not apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put on the child. Do not apply more than 3 times per day to children ages twelve (12) or under.

For ticks and chiggers, also apply to shoe tops, socks and around openings in clothing.

After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. **Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases.
