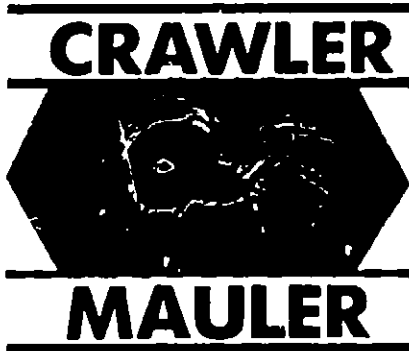

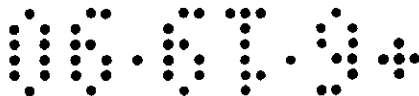
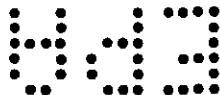

**Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals**

**CAUTION**

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Contains petroleum distillate. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard. Avoid breathing of spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling. Avoid contamination of food, utensils and food preparation areas. Remove pets and cover fish aquariums before spraying. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical attention.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Atropine sulfate is antidotal.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, serving or storage areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

**FLAMMABLE.** Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 150°F may cause bursting.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**General:** In the Home and Non-Food Areas of Industrial Establishments: Spray surfaces to wetting. Print spray away from people, plants and pets. Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, rubber or asphalt surfaces, such as tiles and floor coverings.

**FOR SPOT TREATMENT:**

**Indoor Use:** ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, SCORPIONS, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES (exposed stage), WATERBUGS: Spray into cracks, crevices around baseboards, and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves and in and around waste containers. Repeat as needed. Do not spray foodstuffs or house plants. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Do not allow children to contact treated surfaces until surfaces are completely dry.

**BROWN DOG TICKS:** Spray sleeping quarters of ticks around baseboards, window and door frames, wall tracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spraying. Do not spray animals.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air.

APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS IS NOT PERMITTED.

**Outdoor Use:** ANTS, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, FLEAS, MILLIPEDES, SOWBUGS, AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray infested areas thoroughly, including outside surfaces of doors, screens, window frames, foundations, patios, or other places where insects may enter. For ants, spray hills and runways. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**Storage:** Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

**Disposal:** Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
