Dear Ms. Hartis:

The above referenced labeling, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the following comments:

- Revise the precautionary statement "Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling" to read "*Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco*".
- Under Precautionary Statements, revise 2nd paragraph to read ". . . *In the home, cover all food processing surfaces and utensils during treatment, and thoroughly wash before use. Cover or remove exposed food*".
- Under DFU, delete the phrase "**Repeat as necessary**", and replace a specific application interval, based on approved product performance data.

Please note that we have approved the amended labeling for this product with the understanding that it is consistent with the Agency's previously stamped accepted labels. 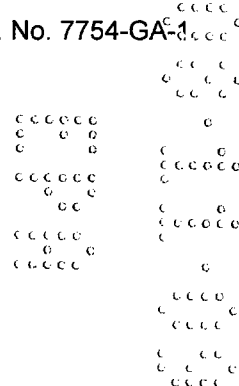

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For Control of Wasps and Hornets: It is preferable to apply this product in the evening after all insects have returned to the nest. Aim valve opening at the nest and depress button, continuing to spray until the nest is soaked with the spray. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!

If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
