Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco, or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms including fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash water or rinsate. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treated areas. This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Restrictions

- Do not contaminate food and feedstuffs.
- Do not use in commercial food/feed processing, preparation, storage, or serving areas.
- All food/feed processing surfaces and utensils must be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover or remove exposed food/feed.
- Do not apply when food is present. Exposed food must be covered or removed.
- Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.
- Do not water treated area to the point of runoff.
- Do not make applications during rain.
- All outdoor applications must be limited to spot, or crack-and-crevice, and wasp and hornet nest treatments only.
- Do not enter or allow others to enter treated area until sprays have dried.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children or pets, either directly or through drift.

For Control of Nests of Wasps, Yellowjackets and Hornets [] []

The best time to spray the nest is in the early morning or early evening, when the air temperature is cooler, most insects are in the nest, and little activity is observed around the nest opening. Spray only if the air is still. Stand at a safe distance from the nest. Do not stand directly under the nest. Hold container upright at arm's length and point the actuator at the nest. First, spray the opening of the nest. Then, spray the rest of the nest until it is saturated. Treated insects may fall out of the nest and die. Any insects returning to the nest after treatment will be killed. Wait 48 hours before removing the nest. Hose off foliage of desirable plants contacted with spray.

For Scorpions, stand 3-4 feet away and thoroughly cover [the insect]. Make sure scorpions are dead before removing.

This product may stain or adversely affect vinyl, painted and plastic surfaces. Avoid application to asphalt roofing shingles as staining may occur. Flush with water if contact occurs. Test in an inconspicuous area and recheck in a few hours before using in areas where spray may contact these surfaces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Never pour unused product down the drain.
