

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND
DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION

Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Harmful if swallowed. Cover or remove exposed foods. Avoid contamination of cooking utensils and food preparation surfaces. Remove pets and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

FIRST AID

If in eyes: Flush with water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerate. **Bee Stings:** has no flash point.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use in and around hotels, motels, homes, greenhouse and bathhouses, food handling establishments, packaging and processing plants, seed houses, commercial, industrial, office, institutional and storage buildings, milk-handling areas of milk plants, milk storage rooms, egg processing plants, supermarkets, restaurants, bottling plants, canneries, flour and feed mills, bakeries, boats, ship cabins and hospitals. In hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Also for use in buses, automobiles, trucks, boxcars and ship cargo holds. Also for use in dog kennels and horse stables. In horse stables, not for application if horses will be used for food.

In food handling areas, food should be removed or covered previous to treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using. Apply only when facility is not in operation. Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

INDOORS: To kill wasps, hornets, yellow jackets: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, particularly under rafters, contacting as many insects as possible. Saturate areas in and around nest openings. Repeat as necessary.

To kill spiders: Spray directly on these pests and use repeated applications to the webbing and in cracks and crevices which harbor spiders.

OUTDOORS: To kill wasps, hornets, yellow jackets: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Aim spray at nest openings in trees, bushes, under eaves, chimneys, cracks and crevices. Saturate in and around nest openings. Contact as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

To kill spiders: same as directed for indoor applications.
