

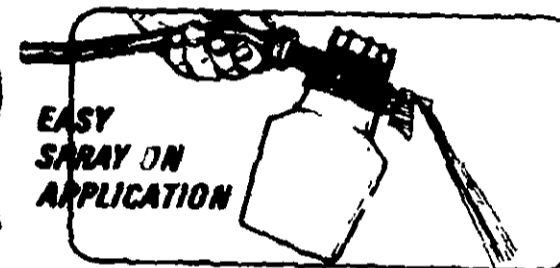

For maximum effect, Heritage House Garden Weed Preventer Wettable Powder must be applied before weed germination occurs or immediately after the soil in the beds has been cultivated and growing weeds removed. One application gives up to three months' weed control — effectively prevents the following:

THE FOLLOWING SPECIES OF ORNAMENTALS, SHRUBS, AND FLOWERS CAN BE TREATED: Abelia, Arbor-vitae, Ash, Azalea, Barberry, Boxwood, Camellia, Cottonwood, Dogwood, Elm, Euonymus, Fir, Forsythia, Hawthorn, Holly, Japanese Ardisia, Juniper, Lantana, Lilac, Locust, Magnolia, Maple, Oak, Pachistima, Variegated Privet, Viburnum, Weigela, Yew, Honey Suckle, Pachysandra, Weigela, English Ivy, Agave, Aloysia, Aster, Baby's Breath, Bleeding Heart, Camellia, Jack-in-the-bush, Evening primrose, Fernleaf yarrow, Feverfew, Forget-me-not, Geranium, Gladiolus, Golden marguerite, Golden tuft, Lupine, Marigold, Morning pink, Mourning bride, Petunia, Poker plant, Purple cornflower, Rose Moss, Rose, Salvia, Scarlet sage, Snapdragon, Sunflower, Verbena, Zinnia.

DIRECTIONS

HOW TO APPLY

To determine the correct amount of Heritage House Dacthal Garden Weed Preventer to use and to insure that it is properly applied, the following procedure is suggested. As with any herbicide application, a number of factors such as rate, type or sprayer, pressure and nozzle size must be taken into consideration.

- 1) Add a specific amount of water (1 gallon) to the sprayer and determine the amount of area that you can cover uniformly with this amount.

Note: The speed at which you walk and the tank pressure can greatly affect the rate of application. Attempt to always operate sprayers at the same pressure and to walk at a constant speed.

- 2) Measure area to be treated.
- 3) Select dosage rate from chart (dilution chart below) for area to be treated.
- 4) Add the proper amount of water to sprayer as determined by the measurement of the area sprayed in Step 2.
- 5) Measure out required amount of Heritage House Garden Weed Preventer and add to sprayer. Allow powder to become wet, then shake vigorously to insure uniform suspension in the water.
- 6) Apply uniformly to area to be treated. Shake the spray tank vigorously at regular intervals (1-2 minutes) to maintain adequate suspension.

If you're using a small sprayer, it may be necessary to divide the area into small plots which then are sprayed one at a time.

- 7) Water lightly after application.

WHEN TO USE

- (1) TURF — Apply on established lawns in early spring, up to time when Forsythia blooms start to fall. For Annual Bluegrass (Poa Annua) control, apply an additional late summer application at 1½ recommended rate.
- (2) SHRUBS — ORNAMENTALS — FLOWER BEDS — Use immediately after transplanting of new plants or any time after plant beds have been weeded or soil clean cultivated. Use only on beds of established flowers and shrubs.
- (3) VEGETABLES

CROPS	WHEN TO APPLY
Broccoli, Brussel Sprouts, Cauliflower, Onions, Shallots, Beans, Kale, Turnips, Potatoes, Garlic, Cabbage	Apply at time of seeding or transplanting.
Cucumbers, Squash, Watermelons, Tomatoes, Cantaloupe, Honeydew.	Apply 4 to 6 weeks after seeding or transplanting.
Lettuce — (leaf).	Apply one application only — not later than 3 weeks after emergence.
Lettuce — (head).	Apply one application only — 1-6 weeks after seeding.
Sweet Potatoes, Yams, Eggplants and Peppers.	Apply at time of transplanting. Delayed application can be made up to 6 weeks after planting.
Strawberries.	NEW PLANTING — Apply at time of planting. ESTABLISHED PLANTING — Apply in fall and early spring. Do not apply after first bloom.

DILUTION RATES FOR MIXING

AREA	AMOUNT OF PRODUCT	AMOUNT OF WATER
250 Sq. Ft.	3 Level Tablespoons	½ Gallon Water
500 Sq. Ft.	6 Level Tablespoons	1 Gallon Water
1,000 Sq. Ft.	12 Level Tablespoons	2 Gallons Water

WARNING

Do not use on Tananthera, Geum, Germander Button Pink, Bugle Weed, Pansy, Carnations, Phlox, or Sweet William. Keep children and pets off treated areas until well watered and completely dry.

Note — On lawns, apply on established lawns when grass is dry. Apply over entire area. Water area after application. Do not use on bent lawns. Refrain from seeding new lawns or bare areas until 60 days after application. Some thinning of fine leaved fescue grasses has been observed. Thoroughly clean sprayer before using for other purposes. Do not contaminate ornamental fish ponds.

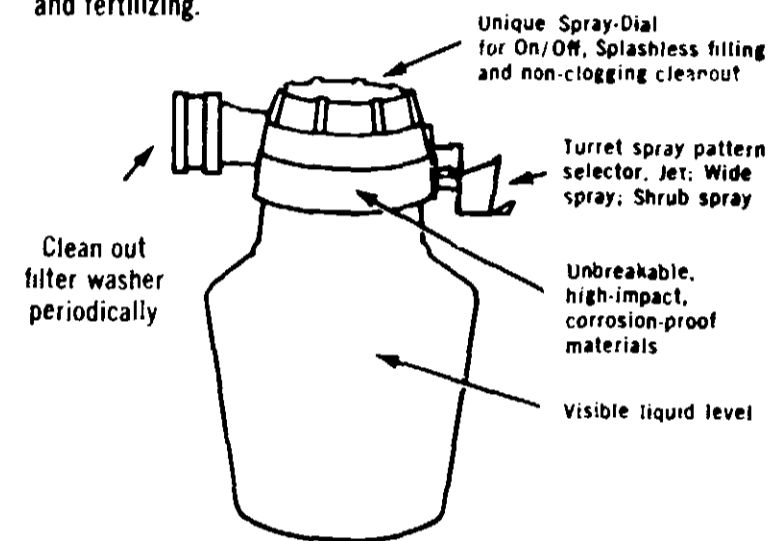
