Working from inside the plant, the insecticide kills sucking insects that feed on the plant sap.

WHEN TO USE: Spray early in Spring, repeating every 10—14 days as necessary to maintain insect control.

HOW TO USE: Apply with either tank type or hose end sprayer. Spray thoroughly covering upper, lower sides of leaves, other plant parts.

MIXING DIRECTIONS: Mix 2 tablespoons (1 fluid ounce) of Systemic Insect Spray per gallon of water. Be careful not to splash concentrate on skin. If concentrate touches skin, wash immediately with soap and water. Discard empty bottle. Do not re-use.

RESTRICTIONS

Plant injury from HERITAGE HOUSE ALL PURPOSE INSECT SPRAY applications has been observed on Royal Purple Smoke trees and on certain varieties of carnations and zinnias. For these three kinds of plants, treat only a few plants and observe for 4 to 5 days before spraying the entire planting.

Do Not handle treated plants until the spray deposit has dried.

Do not use on plants used for food or forage. Use only according to label directions.
