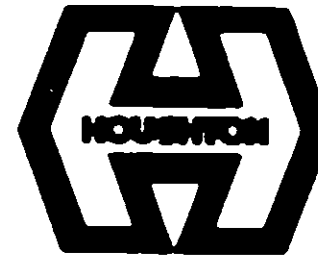

It is recommended for pulp stock and the preservation of coating systems in the form of pulp and paperboard. The dosage rate varies between 0.4 and 2.0 pounds (6-28 fl ozs. of product) per ton of pulp or paper produced depending on mill conditions. Slime 14 may be added anywhere in the system prior to the sheet forming area or in the recirculating white water system.

Slime 14 may be used as a preservative for coating preparations used in the manufacture and coating of paper and paperboard intended for food contact applications in accordance with Food Additive Regulation 176.230.

Dosage rates vary with the degree of preservation required.

In the cases of slurries of starches, acids, protein, plus some titanium dioxide, clay and other pigments, or in blends thereof, typical Slime 14 dosage is in the 250-500 ppm (32-64 fl ozs. of product per 1000 gallons) range.

Slime 14 is added to the slurry makeup water in batch preparation systems, or directly to the slurry prior to the holding tank, or continuous makeup systems.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open burning is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

STORAGE

Do not store near open flame or excessive heat. Protect from freezing. Store in areas with adequate ventilation. Damaged or leaking containers should be handled immediately.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL
