DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Slimex No. 15 is used industrially for controlling the growth of bacteria and fungi. Specifically, it controls the growth of slime-forming organisms in paper mills. It is recommended for slime control in white water and the preservation of pulp stock. Add Slimex 15 anywhere in the system prior to sheet formation, or to the recirculating white water system. The dosage rate varies between 0.4 and 2.0 pounds per ton of pulp or paper produced depending on mill conditions. Detailed information on application procedures will be furnished on request.
