DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Slimex 36 is intended for use in paper mills to control the growth of slime forming bacteria and fungi. It is recommended for slime control in paper mill white water systems.

The dosage rate varies between 0.2 and 1.2 pounds per ton of paper produced depending on mill conditions.

Slimex 36 is normally dispensed directly from the container by means of a positive displacement pump. It can be fed continuously or intermittently. On occasion normal slug addition is used. Typical points of addition are the machine chest consistency regulator, hydro-pipe or saveall.

Technical assistance concerning specific mill problems will be furnished on request.

DANGER! KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Irritant. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. May be absorbed through skin. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds or public water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste. Apply this product only as specified on this label. Do not reuse empty drum. Return to drum conditioner or destroy by perforation, crushing and burying in a safe place away from water supplies.
