

Directions For Use:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Use at night before retiring, or at times of low water flow.
2. For sewer and septic systems, Use Roebic Root EndZ twice yearly at the rate of one quart to each 75 to 100 feet of sewer or septic lines. Apply in a toilet nearest sewer or septic lines. For toilets, flush after each quart of application. If sewer or septic line is completely blocked, use mechanical or chemical methods to obtain some flow. Follow with repeat treatments until free flow is restored. Resume with semi-annual preventive treatments. You may also treat a septic tank drainfield through the distribution box. Do Not apply through sinks or tub drains.
3. For roots in separate bathroom or laundry wastewater systems, pour into a bathroom toilet, floor drain or laundry standpipe drain and follow with 2-3 gallons of water to move the product to the area of root intrusion.

Storage & Disposal

Storage: Store only in tightly closed original container in a secure area inaccessible to children. Avoid storage near food and feed. Always store container in an upright position. **Disposal: If empty:** Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drains except as directed above.
