FOR CRAWLING INSECTS: Ants, Crickets, Centipedes -- spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Spray legs of tables and chairs to repel crawling insects. Spray ant hills and trails thoroughly for best control.

FOR BITING INSECTS: Mosquitoes, Fleas, Ticks, and other biting insects -- spray the area where they are most likely to be found. Do not spray directly on the skin. Do not get the product in your eyes, nose, or mouth. If you do get it in your eyes, nose, or mouth, wash thoroughly with water. If you get it on your skin, wash it off with soap and water. Avoid prolonged or repeated skin contact.
