DIRECTIONS

BATHROOM - To aid in combating odors and to remove most stubborn stains from LAVATORIES, BATHTUBS, TOILET BOWLS, Etc., after thoroughly cleansing, rinse with solution of two tablespoons of KALEX to each gallon of water used. Pour solution into toilet bowl and let stand before flushing.

KITCHENS - To freshen and aid in combating mold, odors and bacteria in REFRIGERATORS, PANTRIES, VEGETABLE BINS; cleanse thoroughly, then wash with a solution of 2 tablespoons KALEX to each quart of water. Rinse. Dry. Repeat treatment when mold growth reappears.

COOKING UTENSILS, DISHES, FRUIT JARS, CAPS AND RINGS: If stained or malodorous, wash thoroughly and immerse in solution of 2 tablespoons of KALEX to each quart of water. Rinse thoroughly.

To bleach, deodorize and disinfect COFFEE BAGS, MOPS, TOWELS, DISHRAGS, first wash thoroughly, rinse; soak in 2 tablespoons of KALEX to each quart of water; rinse.

To cleanse and remove stains from LINOLEUM, TILE, CEMENT, PAINTED WALLS or FLOORS, and UNPOLISHED WOOD SURFACES follow customary methods of cleaning. Rinse with solution of 1 cup of KALEX to a pail of warm water. Rinse. Dry. **SINK STAINS:** After sink has been thoroughly washed, apply KALEX undiluted, allow to stand a few minutes, rinse.

ODORS: To aid in destroying onion, garlic, fish and other obnoxious odors, first wash article or surface thoroughly, then soak from 5 to 15 minutes in a solution of 1 tablespoon of KALEX to each quart of water used. To bleach and remove stains from DRAIN BOARDS, BREAD BOARDS, Etc., first thoroughly wash, then soak from 5 to 15 minutes in a solution of 2 tablespoons KALEX to each quart of water; then rinse.

FOR SWIMMING AND WADING POOLS - In swimming pools use one pint of bleach for every 3,000 gallons of new water. Bleach should be diluted when adding to pool water if not added through a chlorinator. Bleach should be added daily (1/2 pint for every 3,000 gallons). In wading pools use 1/4 cup for every 100 gallons of water and replenish daily. Water should be frequently tested with a suitable chlorine test kit. Add bleach as necessary to maintain a chlorine content of 0.6 to 1.0 parts per million at all times.

DIRECTIONS

LAUNDRY - To bleach white cottons and linens, mix thoroughly 1 tablespoon of KALEX to each gallon of the regular solution used in the soaking, washing or rinsing. Rinse thoroughly in clear water before drying or ironing. Boiling unnecessary.

BABY'S THINGS: To bleach baby's white cottons and linens, mix well 1 tablespoon of KALEX to each gallon of the regular solution used in the soaking, washing or rinsing. Rinse thoroughly in clear water before drying or ironing. Boiling unnecessary.

TO DISINFECT: Clothes must be thoroughly washed and rinsed and then soaked from 5 to 15 minutes in a solution of 2 tablespoons of KALEX to each gallon of water; rinse in clear water.

GENERAL DISINFECTANT: Walls, woodwork, ranges, utensils, floors. - Clean object first with warm suds, then apply solution of 4 tablespoons KALEX for each gallon of cold water. Soak 5 minutes. Rinse well.

FOR HOUSEHOLD, SCHOOLS, INSTITUTIONS - GLASSWARE, DISHES, EATING AND COOKING UTENSILS: First thoroughly wash and rinse to remove all soil and food particles; disinfect by immersing from 5 to 10 minutes in a solution of 2 tablespoons of KALEX to each gallon of water. Rinse, drain and dry. This procedure also removes stains from tea and coffee pots. Keep KALEX solution clean and free from food particles.

To cleanse, remove stains, deodorize and disinfect **COUNTERS, DRAIN BOARDS, FLOORS, TILE, MARBLE, PORCELAIN**: Wash thoroughly and rinse. Then soak with a solution of 4 tablespoons of KALEX to each gallon of water used. Rinse. Dry.
