

# WEBFOOT WEED AND FEED

WEBFOOT WEED AND FEED is a combination Plant Food and Selective Weedkiller. It supplies a balanced combination of Plant Food Nutrients to maintain a green, healthy lawn; Contains the Herbicide 2,4-D to kill the broadleaved weeds, Plantain and Dandelions, and the Herbicide Silvex to kill clovers and chickweed.

## DIRECTIONS

SPREAD CONTENTS OF THIS BAG EVENLY OVER 2,500 sq. ft. of LAWN. (50x50) Set spreader at a low setting or so that the hole openings are slightly smaller than 1/4 inch in diameter. See spreader settings below.

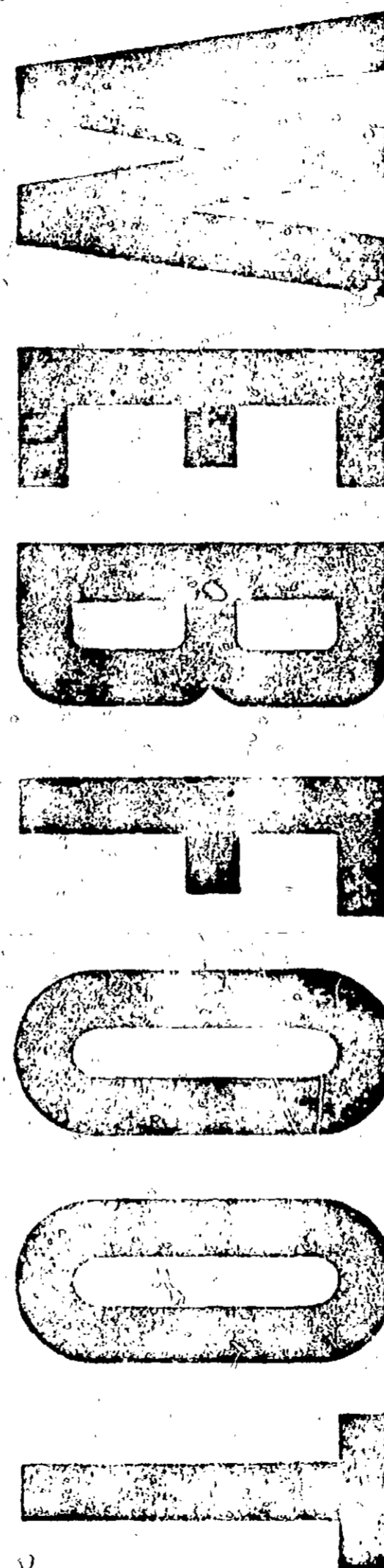
1. Apply when weeds are present and growing vigorously, preferably when they are young.
2. Application should be made following light rain, dew or light sprinkling previous to applying. (Grass should be damp enough so that WEBFOOT WEED AND FEED will adhere.)
3. Apply on a windstill day. The temperature should be at least 60° but not above 90° for 2 days following application.
4. Apply 3 days after mowing when weeds are actively growing.
5. Do not water treated lawn for 2 days or mow for 5 days after treatment.
6. Do not apply to new lawns until they are well established.

NOTE: Heavy rainfall, watering or traffic on treated area within 24 hours after application will minimize results.

Some browning of grass may appear after application but will normally disappear following next mowing.

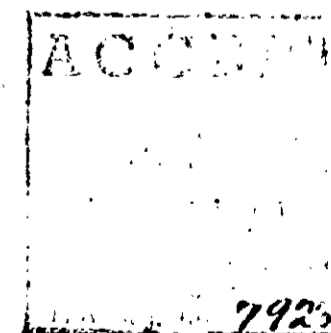
