DIRECTIONS

DEODORIZING — Mix two or three tablespoons of Bleach
with a quart of soapy water. Wash thoroughly and rinse with
clear water. This solution will clean and deodorize: **REFRIGER-**
ATORS — ENAMELWARE — GLASSWARE — BATH TUBS —
LINOLEUMS — TILE FLOORS.

REMOVING STAINS from white cotton and linen goods: Wash
out starch or dressing. Mix two tablespoons of Bleach with each
quart of cold water. Soak for ten to fifteen minutes. Rinse well
in clear water. The above method will remove the following
stains: **INK — FRUIT — VEGETABLES — FLOWERS — TEA —**
COFFEE — SCORCH — MILDEW. Lemon juice or vinegar will
remove any brown spots remaining after removing certain types
of ink.

DO NOT REUSE EMPTY CONTAINER. Destroy it by
perforating or crushing it. Bury or discard in safe place.

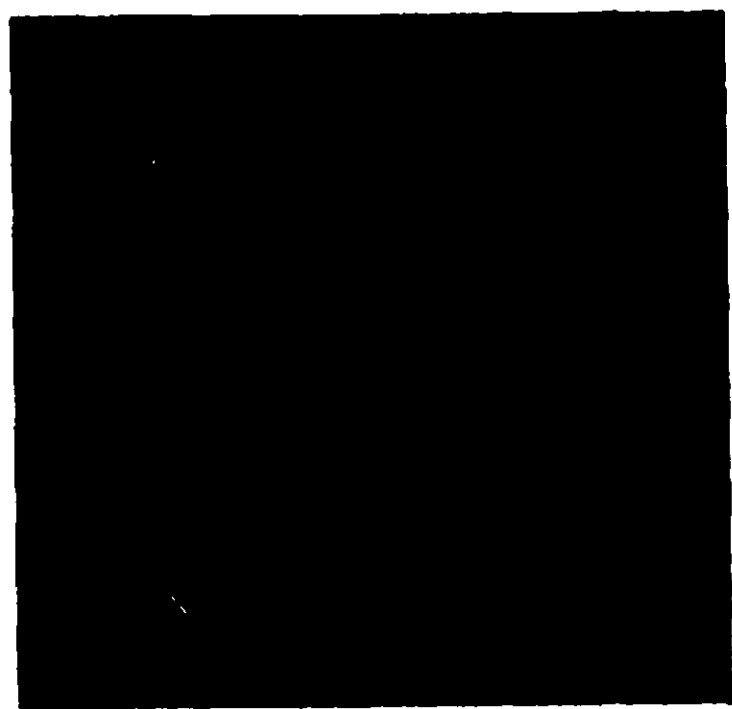

DIRECTIONS

LAUNDRY — Use this Bleach on white and fast color linen and cotton goods.

TUB WASHING — Add one tablespoon of Bleach to each gallon of warm water. Add soap or washing powder and let clothes soak half hour or overnight. Wash and rinse two or three times.

WASHING MACHINE — Add one-half teacup of Bleach to a washer of water and proceed as for tub washing.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN EATING ESTABLISHMENTS AS APPROVED UNDER THE REGULATION OF THE WISCONSIN STATE BOARD OF HEALTH.

1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible.
2. Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner.
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Sanitize in a solution of 2 ounces to 4 gallons of water (200 ppm). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing Sanitary Code.
5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.

Note: A clean potable water rinse following sanitization is not permitted under Section H 96.16 (2) (c) 2 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.
