## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

LAWN LIFE WEED & FEED is formulated to provide your lawn with a complete fertilization while at the same time controlling broad leaf weeds such as plaintain, dandelions, buckton, pigweed, ragweed, sour grass, wild onion and many other lawn weeds.

LAWN LIFE WEED & FEED is formulated to control unsightly broad leaf weeds in your lawn while at the same time feeding the grasses so that they grow vigorously and produce a thick, green weed free turf. This combination is highly effective, economical, easy to use and due to the dry granular form is safer to use than a spray.

LAWN LIFE WEED & FEED can be used during the Spring, Summer or Fall, however, the best results are obtained when the weeds are growing vigorously due to adequate soil moisture and warm days.

1. Apply between mowings to provide sufficient leaf surface to be treated.
2. Sprinkle lawn prior to application or apply after light rainfall.
3. Avoid application during periods of high winds to avoid drift on surrounding plants.
4. Delay application when rain is predicted and do not water the lawn for 24 hours after application.
5. Do not treat new lawns until after the third mowing or when grasses are comparatively well established.
6. Some weeds are more resistant than others and a second application after 10-14 days may be necessary.
7. Apply LAWN LIFE WEED & FEED at the rate of  $4\frac{1}{2}$  pounds per 1000 sq. ft. (25' x 40') which is best accomplished by the use of a lawn spreader set at the number listed below.

### SUGGESTED SPREADER SETTINGS:

LAWN BEAUTY	8
SCOTT'S	6
JACKSON	5

These suggestions are for your guidance in spreading LAWN LIFE WEED & FEED, and are in no sense a guarantee of exact application. Age, condition of spreader, speed of operation and roughness of terrain can cause variations in rates applied.

**CAUTION:** Avoid inhalation or contamination of food stuffs. Wash hands after handling.

Do not store near fertilizer, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. Do not allow dust to drift onto susceptible plants such as ornamentals, vegetables, etc.  
Bent grasses and clover may exhibit slight injury however they will recover after a short period when product is used as directed.
