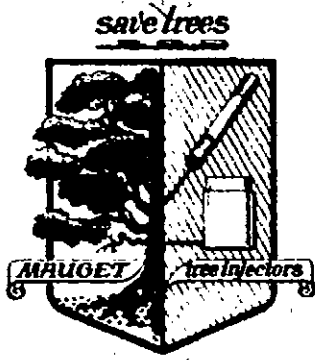

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool place with units in an upright position.  
Dispose of empty containers in an approved landfill or bury in a safe place away from water supplies. In case of spillage wash down with large amounts of water. Decontaminate areas and equipment by washing with concentrated solution of alkali and detergent and rinse with water.
