Do not inject trees that are less than two inches in diameter.

Do not inject trees within two weeks of any other spray or soil chemical treatment.

Do not treat trees that are suffering from stress such as lack of moisture or herbicide damage.

This product is not to be used on trees which will produce food within the year following treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal of microinjection capsules.
Do not reuse microinjection capsules.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store capsules in an upright position, above 45°, in a cool, dry place.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Dispose of empty capsules in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if approved by State and local authorities.
