DIRECTIONS

SWIMMING POOL ALGAECIDE

1. If algae growth is observed, add one gallon of Metalene Algaecide No. 2120 for each 70,000 gallons of water.
2. As dead algae growths fall to bottom of pool, vacuum thoroughly and backwash filter when pressure increases. When pool is clean, add one gallon of Metalene Algaecide No. 2120 for each 25,000 gallons of water.
3. At the beginning of the season when algae growth is absent, add 3 gallons of Metalene Algaecide No. 2120 for each 50,000 gallons of water in the pool. The Algaecide should be poured into the pool along the edge. Avoid physical contact until Algaecide has been dispersed.
4. A regular dosage of 1 gallon of Metalene Algaecide No. 2120 should be added for each 50,000 gallons of water each 4 to 5 days. Maintain between 2 ppm and 5 ppm of active ingredients for control of algae growth. See Serviceman for suitable test kit.
