ACTIVE INGREDIENTS

n-Alkyl (60% C₁₄, 30% C₁₆, 5% C₁₂, 5% C₁₈)
dimethyl benzyl ammonium chlorides.....6.25%
n-Alkyl (50% C₁₂, 30% C₁₄, 17% C₁₆, 3% C₁₈)
dimethyl ethylbenzyl ammonium chlorides..6.25%
Dis (tributyltin) oxide.....5 %

INERT INGREDIENTS

Water.....82.5 %

METALENE BIOCIDES

Use at the rate of 1 to 2 ounces for
each 100 gallons of water in system.

Application should be made once every
second day until algae and slimes are
killed off as determined by inspection.

A regular treatment dosage of 1.0 to
1.5 ounces for each 100 gallons of water
once each 3-4 days will normally prevent
regrowth.
