The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provisions:

1) We have noted that the Precautionary Statements have been revised and are no longer appropriate in conjunction with the "Caution" signal word. In order to change the Precautionary Statements to the language on the proposed labeling, toxicity data must be submitted to the Agency to justify the change. If you feel that a change in toxicity category is appropriate, please submit the referenced data. Otherwise, rewrite the Precautionary Statements to read "Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing dust" as per the label accepted on November 26, 1971.

2) The Precautionary Statements referenced above, the Protective Clothing statement, and the statements "Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking," currently within the Statement of Practical Treatment, must be relocated. They belong within the "Precautionary Statements" section directly beneath the subheading "Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals."

3) Within the Statement of Practical Treatment, change the last sentence of the "If Swallowed" statement to read "Never induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."

Delete the statement "Pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies" from the Storage and Disposal block. It contradicts the required statements as prescribed in the Registration Standards for this product.

5. Add the statement "Do not contaminate water used for irrigation or domestic purposes."
