Dear Dr. Jordan:

The label amendment you submitted for the product referred to above has been reviewed by the Agency. The draft label requires the following changes before it is acceptable:

- 1. Revise the active and inert ingredient concentrations (page 1) because the concentration of active ingredient in the source material has changed. This also necessitates submitting a revised confidential statement of formula (CSF).
- 2. Add an EPA Est. No. next to the EPA Reg. No.
- 3. Move the FIRST AID table (including the Hot Line and Note to Physician statements) to top of the page, before the "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS."
- 4. Replace "Do not discharge into lakes, EPA Regional Office" under the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD STATEMENT" with "Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NDPES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."
- 5. Replace "nursery stock" under Non-Food Uses (page 2) with "ornamental plants grown in nurseries only"
