Your Submission Dated October 3, 1991

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provisions:

- 1) Rewrite the first sentence of the Pesticide Disposal statement to read "Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous."
- 2) Rewrite the Container Disposal statement to read "Completely empty bag. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke."

A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Please submit three (3) final printed copies for the referenced label, incorporating the above changes.

Please note that all future submissions must include a properly completed Application for Pesticide Registration/Amendment (EPA Form 8570-1).

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals

DANGER

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not store near other pesticides, fertilizers, or seeds.

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleansing of equipment. Thoroughly clean equipment before using for other purposes. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not contaminate water used for irrigation or domestic purposes.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate, is a violation of Federal Law and may contaminate groundwater.
