There does not appear to be a tolerance established for use of sethoxydim on "pome fruits" as listed on the label. Tolerances have been established only for apple pomace. The label must be revised.

- 3) To the ingredient section add "contains petroleum distillates".
- 4) Per the acute toxicity review, the "IF SWALLOWED" statements must be revised to read:

"IF SWALLOWED:

Immediately call a poison control center or doctor.

Do not induce vomiting unless told to by a poison control center or doctor.

Do not give any liquid to the person.

Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."

- 5) Per the acute toxicity review, a Note to Physician must be added to the label and must read: "Note to Physician May pose an aspiration pneumonia hazard. Contains petroleum distillate."
- 6) To the storage and disposal section of the label:
- -Add text under the Container Disposal heading that describes and identifies the container as refillable or nonrefillable.
- -Revise the heading "Container Disposal" to read "Container Handling."
- 7) Add "or rinseate" after "washwaters" (to the Environmental Hazards section).

Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the record. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Only for formulation into a herbicide for the following uses: (1) asparagus, beans (dry & succulent), beet (garden), blueberry, brassica, bulb vegetables, caneberries, canola/crambe/rapeseed, carrot, cherries (sweet & sour), citrus, clover, corn, cotton, cranberry, cucurbits, date, deciduous trees, non-food crop areas, fallow land, fescue, (tall), flax, fruiting vegetables, grape, head & petiole type vegetables, horseradish, lentil, leafy vegetables, mint, nectarine, orchard floor middles, peach, peanut, peas (dry & succulent), porne fruits, potatoes, root & tuberous corms, set aside conservation land, soybean, strawberry, sugar beet, sunflower, tobacco seedbeds, tree nuts, tree farms, nonbearing food crops, ornamental and nursery plantings, rights of way, wildflowers and turf; (2) uses for which US EPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration; and (3) uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with US EPA regulations. This product may be used to formulate products for any additional uses not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with US EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such uses.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry place

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
